Day 01	<p>Kuala Lumpur > Siem Reap (Lunch & Dinner) Upon arrival in Siem Reap international airport, you will meet & greet by our local representatives then transfer for hotel check – in. However, early check – in to hotel are subject to rooms availability; standard check – in hours are after 1400 hours or 2p.m. You may rest and relax at the hotel or rejuvenate yourself at the local SPA with an aromatic massage (optional item). Tour programs will start by 1200 hours with lunch serves at local restaurant then follow by tour excursions to Les Artisan D'Angkor, a handicraft centre for wood & stone carving. Visit Wat Bo which was founded in the 18th century, a large pagoda with very unique wall paintings of the Reamker (Ramajana); Wat Thmei (Killing Field) a unique glass –walled stupa containing the bones of Khmer Rouge victims. Around 1600 hours transfer for program highlights of the day to Phnom Bakheng (Bakheng Hills), dominating the flat landscape; this 10th Century mountain temple is the most popular spot in the area to watch a classic sunset over Angkor Wat and the surroundings. After dinner serves at local restaurant, transfer back to hotel, tour programs end.</p>
Day 02	<p>Siem Reap > The Ancient Temples Of Angkor > Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner) Today's program highlight to the ancient walled city, South Gate of Angkor Thom, literally "Great City, "built in the 12th century by Jayavarman VII, contains the famous Bayon Temple, is a three-tiered pyramid with fifty-four towers and is quite an amazing sight, each of these towers is carved to depict over two hundred huge enigmatic faces of Avalokitesharva that bear down on you wherever you turn; Bapuon, originally a 43-meter tall, three tiered pyramid representing the mythical Mount Meru, suffered a series of collapses. In 1943, half the north face of the second and third tiers also suddenly crumbled; Terrace of the Elephant with its large sculptured royal elephants and Garudas, the mythical guard half-man, half-bird. Also within the walled area is the Terrace Of The Leper King, Phimeanakas, next visit to Ta Prohm one of the most spectacular temples in the Angkor area; moss and gnarled and entwined tree roots have broken their way through the centuries old stonework and cover this temple. After lunch serves at local restaurant, you will be free at own leisure for shopping at the local market and enjoy an hour of traditional foot reflexology or body massage continue to visit Thommanan, Chaosay, Ta Keo Temples. Enjoy sunset discovery of The World Heritage of Angkor Wat, the magnificent remains of the Khmer civilization which was built in the 12th century by King Suryavarman II and is the largest religious artifact in the entire world. Angkor Wat's rising series of five towers culminates in an impressive central tower that symbolizes mythical Mount Meru; thousands of feet of wall space are covered with intricate carving depicting scenes from Hindu mythology. Enjoy Khmer's delights' & international menus buffet style dinner with traditional & cultural shows. Transfer back to hotel, tour programs end.</p>
Day 03	<p>Siem Reap > Kuala Lumpur (Breakfast) Transfer to airport for flight home with sweet memory or you may extend your stay with additional costs.</p>
